WHAT DOES MY CHILD HAVE TO DO?

Students must demonstrate proof of summer reading by completing the attached Reading Journal or providing the same information on separate sheets of paper for **at least 5 books** read. The Reading Journal includes a Reading Log and five pages for students to draw/write reading responses.

The assignments are considered part of the child's reading requirement for the first trimester of the 2010 – 2011 school year and will be given a grade.

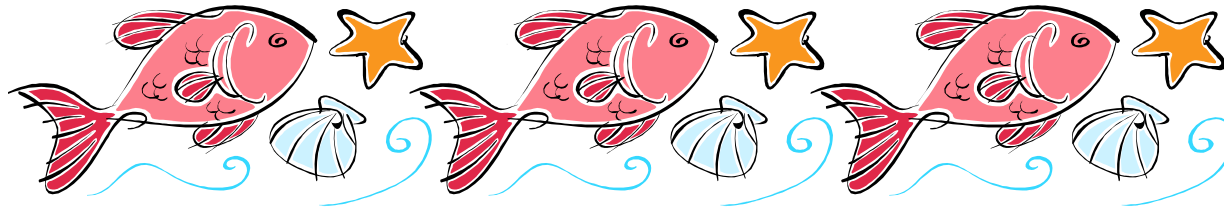

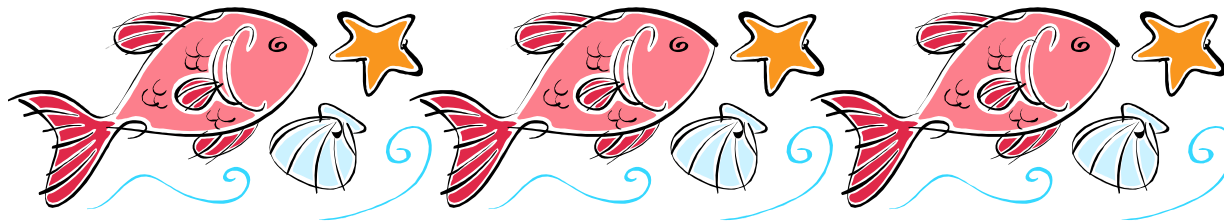
