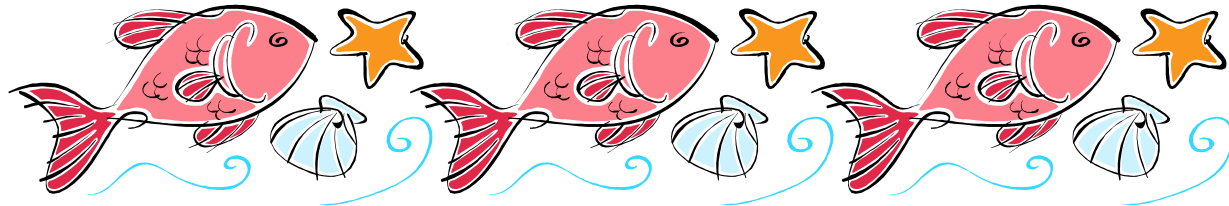

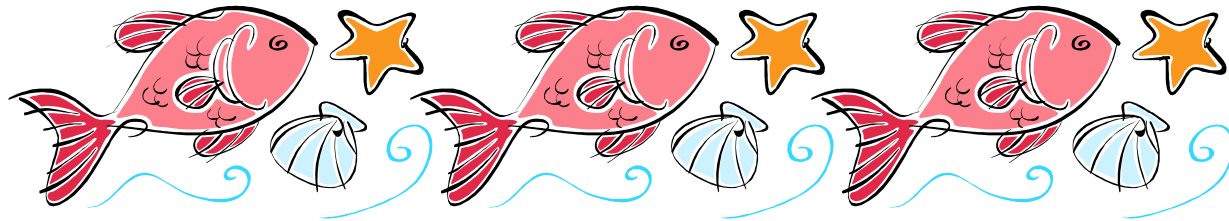

In order to help our students meet this expectation, we require all students to read <u>ten books</u> over the summer months. Students may read <u>ANY BOOK</u> of their choice including poetry, folktales, fairytales, informational, and memoir. Any teacher, school librarian, or public librarian can help students choose books of their choice at their reading levels.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>WHAT DOES MY CHILD HAVE TO DO?</u></p> <p>Students must demonstrate proof of summer reading by completing the attached Reading Journal or providing the same information on separate sheets of paper for <u>at least 5 books</u> read. The Reading Journal includes a Reading Log and five pages for students to draw/write reading responses.</p> <p>The assignments are considered part of the child's reading requirement for the first trimester of the 2010 – 2011 school year and will be given a grade.</p>
