WHAT DOES MY CHILD HAVE TO DO?

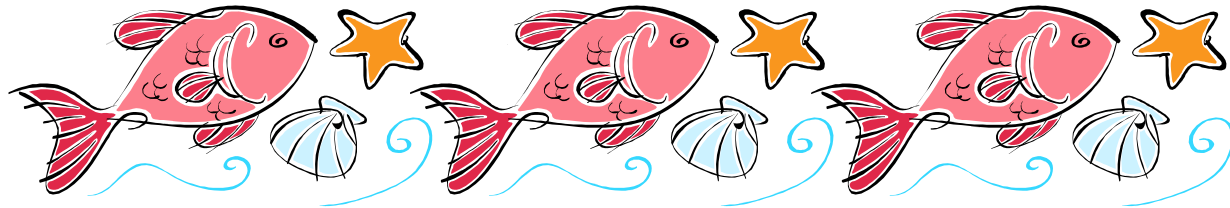

The assignments are considered part of the child's reading requirement for the first trimester of the 2010 – 2011 school year and will be given a grade..

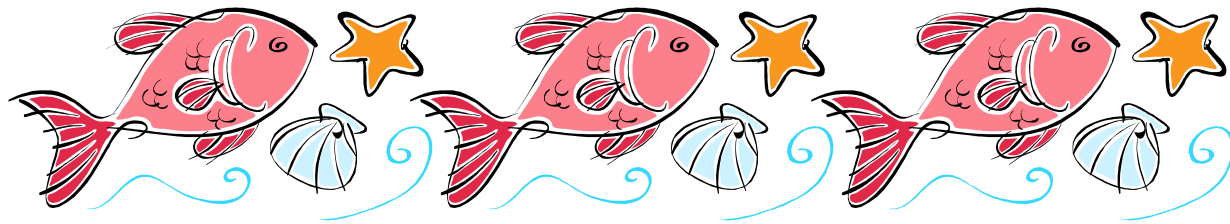
